

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING EXHIBITION DRIVING IN THE COUNTY OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA

The Board of Commissioners of Roseau County, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I.

It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to

Subd. 1 operate a vehicle on a public highway, street, parking lot, alley, or other public property in such manner as to cause the tires to squeal, or the gears to grind or the motor to backfire, except when an emergency creates a necessity for such operation.

Subd. 2 drive or operate a vehicle on a public highway, street, parking lot, alley, or other public property at erratic or irregular and changing speeds or to skid or slide upon acceleration or deceleration or to cause a vehicle to unnecessarily sway or turn abruptly, when any such behavior will create a hazard to the driver himself or other persons or property or interfere with other traffic in the area.

SECTION II.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

This Ordinance shall be effective with passage and approval as provided by law.
