Each county in Minnesota is awarded a grant from the state to provide funding for child care to low-income families. Child Care Assistance can help individuals pay child care costs for children ages 12 and younger, and for children ages 13 and 14 who have special needs. Child care costs may be paid for time at work, looking for work, or attending training. The amount of child care assistance depends on family income, size, and other eligibility factors.
