

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 3 AND ORDINANCE NO. 12 OF THE COUNTY OF ROSEAU, MINNESOTA, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES."

The County Board of Roseau County ordains:

That Ordinance No. 3, and Ordinance No. 5, and Ordinance No. 10, and Ordinance No. 11, and Ordinance No. 12 of Roseau County, Minnesota, be amended as follows:

That the County of Roseau, State of Minnesota, has established solid waste management facilities on property located in Enstrom Township, Roseau County, Minnesota, and that anyone using said facilities shall pay to the Roseau County Treasurer the sum of \$10.00 per cubic yard of waste, plus the amount of the Minnesota sales tax which is applicable.

That if the user of said facilities fails or neglects to pay said charges, including applicable sales tax, the Board of Commissioners can certify the same to the Roseau County Auditor who shall levy said charges against the real estate owned by the user, and the same shall be collected with other taxes. In the case of any village or governmental unit using said facilities and failing to pay the user fee, including the applicable sales tax, the Board of County Commissioners can certify said amount to the County Auditor who shall levy a sufficient amount on all property in said governmental unit to pay said amount.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.



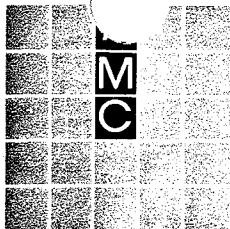
