POSITION: Investigator

Roseau County is accepting applications for the position of Investigator. Under direction of the Sheriff, this is a Grade 8 position.

Preferred candidates should possess the ability to perform the following essential duties and responsibilities: Investigate felony level crimes and conduct child protection investigations; conduct interviews; obtain statements and collect/obtain evidence; perform surveillance activities and prepare and execute search warrants; determine priorities of crimes and investigations, plan investigations and tactical operations; develop informants; arrest suspects; prepare all written documentation necessary for the prosecution of cases; testify in court; serve civil process paperwork as required; coordinate work with other law enforcement agencies and jurisdictions; and perform other related duties as assigned.

Successful candidates must have a minimum of five years law enforcement experience; an Associate's Degree in Law Enforcement/Criminal Justice; have first aid certification; and be able to pass physical and psychological testing and a background check prior to employment. Applicants must be MN POST licensed or eligible to be licensed at the time of hire, hold a valid Minnesota driver's license, have good verbal and written communication skills, be a U.S. citizen, and have no felony convictions.
