

NOTICE: ALL ANTENNA TV WATCHERS

TEMPORARY TV OUTAGES

Due to TV translator frequency changes mandated by the FCC, next week Tuesday, May 29th, through June 1st, there will be temporary TV outages on the PBS channel off the Roseau tower and all channels off the Baudette and Williams towers. The educational channel is received in Roseau County from the Williams tower. This will take most of the week because the antennas atop the 300 foot towers have to be changed to accommodate the new channel changes. The reason you will be losing your signal is because the FCC is mandating TV translators move down in frequency, below channel 52. Roseau Tower channel 52 is moving to channel 38, the Williams Tower is moving from channels 59, 61, and 63 to channels 32, 34, and 36, and the Baudette translator is moving from channels 53, 55, and 57 to channels 25, 16 and 14.

Viewers in these areas should wait until the end of the week, and then re-scan their TVs to accommodate the frequency changes being made at the Williams and Baudette towers.
